






## MEANING OF COLOURS IN VISUAL SIGNALLING EQUIPMENT

With reference to EN 60204-11:2000 the following general use and meanings of colours for visual signalling equipment can be defined:

Colour	Meaning/Explanation	Action by the operator
	emergency dangerous situation	immediate action for reacting in a dangerous situation
	abnormal situation upcoming critical situation	monitor and/or action
	normal situation	optional
	indication of situation requiring a defined action by the operator	conclusive action
	neutral – no particular meaning for other situations to be used if doubts exist when to use red, yellow, green or blue	monitor
